As we begin this New Year 2018 words of Rabindranath Tagore in his Nobel award winning book Gitanjali come to my mind:

Thou hast made me endless, such is Thy pleasure.

This frail vessel thou emptiest again and again,
And fillest it with ever with fresh life.

This little flute of reed thou hast carried over hills and dales,
And hast breathed through it melodies eternally new.

At the immortal touch of thy hands my heart loses
Its limits in joy and gives birth to utterance ineffable.

Thy infinite gifts come to me only on these small hands of mine.
Ages pass, and still thou pourest, and there is room to fill.

The Lord has been very good to us during 2017. Faith journey of our people has been strengthened. He has blessed us all with good health and good cheer. Our pilgrimage to Vellankanni and 5 days retreat at the feet of Our Lady of good health has strengthened our resolve to work for Christ and his church in Baruipur. During 2017 we have been able to bless three new parish churches and a village church. This was to accompany our people in their faith journey. To enhance our accompaniment in the faith journey of our people, we shall keep in mind four aspects of ministry and that will enhance our pastoral effectivity:

Our Collective Responsibility in building the Church in Baruipur Diocese: We must concentrate in building the body of Christ in Baruipur diocese. For this we need first and foremost to be aware of our strengths, weakness, opportunities and challenges. We need also a proper understanding of socio-cultural, religious, political, economic situations prevailing at present in our diocese. Only by doing so, we can play our respective roles with genuine interest and commitment and effectively promote development of our people. For this we must have a collaborative approach in all our pastoral initiatives. It is not possible unless we all co-operate.

Faith Formation: It is a beautiful and meaningful task of building

the body of Christ in our diocese, we cannot forget that it is of paramount importance to bring our people, especially children, the youth, and adults in solid faith, ardent fervour and genuine fellowship. We often say today's children and youth are tomorrow's church. One of the best and effective ways of faith formation is through building up Small Christian Communities. Faith formation of children and youth in our parishes is of paramount importance.

Family Apostolate: From what I said just now, it is clear that it is important to strengthen our families in faith, fervour and fellowship. This is also because the family is the basic nucleus of the domestic church. Family is the foundation of the society and important unit of the church. We need to ensure its stability through solid marriage preparation courses, accompaniment programmes counselling and family visits. We have to make our families harbinger of peace, joy, love and unity. Families are primary means of evangelization.

Joyful Celebration and Participation in the Sacred Liturgy: Liturgy being the highest point in the life of the church, when, gathered together in the name of the Lord as a people of God, we praise and worship the Lord and receive abundant graces and blessings from him for our daily life as Christians. We must make it joyful event where all participate with enthusiasm. We must prepare the liturgy well. There must be attitude of reverence, decorum and dignity. The altar must be well decorated, Vestment must be decent, symbolism of the colours must be kept up. Altar servers must have a uniform dress. Roman missal must be used and Readings to be done from the lectionary or a Bible.

At the beginning of this New Year, 2018, I wish everyone a happy New Year and invite all of you to extend your hand, even if it is weak, to build the body of Christ in the church.
